

# Earn CPR Certification With cardiacSTAR™

### Can I get CPR certified with cardiacSTAR™?

Yes! cardiacSTAR™ measures the quality of CPR performed during the game and tracks your answers to CPR knowledge questions. As a player, do your best to learn all you can about how to give an excellent first aid response. Pay attention to the onscreen guide showing your CPR quality, and always use your own phone inside the cardiacSTAR™ Power Station when it's your turn. This makes sure your results are connected to your phone.

## How do I earn this CPR certification?

If you score 70% or above and you correctly perform CPR, you will automatically be asked on your phone if you wish to become CPR certified. If you say YES, you then will be asked five multiple-choice questions. There is no limit on how many times you can take the test. Once you pass the test and get 100% correct, you can enter your email address and pay a small fee to receive your CPR certification card, good for one year.

#### What if I didn't score at least 70%?

After each game, the CPR instructor can select the STAR Challenge. This allows you, as a player, to practice CPR for two more minutes. It's a second chance to score well and become eligible for CPR certification.

#### What kind of CPR certification is it?

cardiacSTAR™ provides you with 1-year Hands-Only Adult CPR certification. This does not include child, infant or advanced life support training.

## Who accepts cardiacSTAR™ CPR certification?

Most people are surprised to learn there is no single accrediting organization for CPR training. Each workplace decides which CPR certification they accept. You are welcome to check requirements with your employer, school, organization, etc. You can be confident knowing cardiacSTAR™ strictly adheres to international CPR education guidelines, used by fellow industry leaders like the American Heart Association (AHA), International Liaison Committee on Resuscitation (ILCOR) and European Society of Cardiology (ESC). Also, cardiacSTAR™ CPR training leads to better CPR skill retention than comparable courses from AHA or American Red Cross. Furthermore, cardiacSTAR™ is the only gamified CPR course that immerses players in the high-stakes, emotional environment that accompanies real-world responses.
